

- Carnival multi-storey car park

Parking need to know:

- You will not need to get a paid or free vend ticket from RingGo or ticket machines on these days
- This extends from 10pm on the Saturday night before until the Monday morning after each event
- RingGo and the ticket machines will remain fully operational over these times
- Signs will be displayed explaining no payment required
- Refunds will not be available for any payments made during the free parking period

Free bus travel has been arranged by Wokingham Borough Council - see the details here.

Wokingham Station is 5 minutes walk from the Winter Carnival.
